Instruction for Authors

- *The presenting author is expected to attend the congress and present the poster presentation.*
- *The presenting author is required to ensure that all co-authors are aware of the content of the abstract before submission.*
- *All short papers must be submitted in clear English with accurate grammar and spelling of a quality suitable for publication.*

Abstract

Please send the abstract not longer than 250 words before the 15th of March. It must not exceed the first page or contain artwork or references. The abstract should present an introduction, material and method, results and conclusions of the paper. The name of the file should be authors_surname_date, e.g., *Asta_kazlauskaite_20160229*. We kindly ask to bring poster fully assembled and printed, when the abstract is accepted.

Poster format

The poster size is A0, equals 118 cm height x 84 cm length, or smaller. Please choose upright format and keep in mind that the font sizes should be big enough to allow your poster to be read from some distance. We suggest using a font size of 22 – 24 pt. for texts and 60 – 70 pt. for headings. Poster's should be placed not later than 19.00 on 15th of April.

- *All posters will automatically be considered for the Poster Award.*
- *The winner will be formally announced during the closing ceremony.*
- *The posters will be evaluated in terms of coherence, argumentation and methodology, awareness of previous work, attractiveness, message and main points, balance text visuals, and overall impression.*
